MARLDON MXL500 FLOOR PRIME



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Advantages:

Floor primers should be included in most specifications involving the treatment of unfinished timber floors and those sanded back to bare timber. Floor primers effectively seal the surface which prevents the top coat from soaking in to the timber, reduces the risk of side bonding and maximises the overall build of the finish.

Product uses:

MARLDON FLOOR PRIMER is a one pack acrylic primer formulated to prime wooden floors prior to overcoating with Marldon waterbourne flooring lacquers. It is designed to enhance the colour of the timber and improve the overall build of the finish. MARLDON FLOOR PRIMER can be applied to internal hardwood or softwood floors in domestic and commercial uses. Not suitable for use in high humidity areas such as bathrooms and saunas. Preparation:

UNFINISHED BARE TIMBER - The surface needs to be clean, dry and free from all contamination. Pre-sand using 100 or 120 grit paper and remove sanding dust prior to application.

PREVIOUSLY FINISHED FLOORS - Sand the floor back to bare wood removing all the old coating and contamination, then treat as a new unfinished floor.

Application:

Always stir well before use. Apply Marldon Floor Prime with synthetic or Lambswool applicator pad or roller. Ensure an even application of the primer and maintain a wet edge to prevent the formation of overlap marks. Do not use in areas of high humidity or condensation. If required, a light sanding may be carried out before overcoating with Marldon Floor Lacquer.



Drying:

MARLDON FLOOR PRIMER is recoatable after 1-2 hours under normal drying conditions (20°C and 60%RH). Do not use below 15°C as low temperature and high humidity may extend the cure and drying times of the seal.

Coverage:

8-12 sqm per litre, dependent on the surface application.

Cleaning equipment:

Clean tools in water and detergent immediately after use.

Storage:

Store away from frost and direct sunlight.

Health & Safety:

Keep out of reach of children. Refer to health and safety data sheet for individual product information. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and consult a doctor.
